How do I become an apprentice?

Whether you're a school leaver or looking for a new direction with your career, apprenticeships can be a great way to learn new skills while you earn. You need to apply for an apprenticeship just like a full-time job. On Point can help you with that and you can find all of our live vacancies on our website. You will be contacted by our recruitment team to meet you in person or in an online meeting. We will discuss your application with a view to putting you forward for an interview.



What is an apprenticeship?

An apprenticeship is a job where you'll learn, get experience and earn a wage. Rather than sit in a classroom for free you will be earning money every week. You will be employed by a company with a contract of employment and entitled to holiday leave. Apprenticeships can vary in lengths between 12 months and 6 years depending on the level. By the end of your apprenticeship, you'll have the appropriate skills and knowledge needed for your chosen career.

Am I eligible to become an apprentice?

You must be 16 or over to become an apprentice and not already be in full-time education. On Point Apprenticeships is based in Gateshead, and we provide apprenticeships in the North East of England, so to be eligible, you must also live in England. While some people consider apprenticeships an option for young people, you can start an apprenticeship at any age.

Why should I consider an apprenticeship?

If you're a school leaver, apprenticeships provide an alternative to sixth form form, College or University. But you can become an apprentice at any age, and apprenticeships provide a practical way to develop your skills while working and earning.

You can start an apprenticeship whether you're starting your career, want a change, or you're upskilling in your current job. You can have a previous qualification, like a degree, and still start an apprenticeship. If you are considering a career change and already have an undergraduate degree, level 6 and level 7 apprenticeships can help you to progress.

What are the different levels of apprenticeships, and what qualification will I finish with?

Level 2 apprenticeships are classed as Intermediate and are equivalent once completed to GCSEs.

Level 3 apprenticeships are classed as Advanced and are equivalent once completed to A Levels.

Levels 4 & 5 apprenticeships are classed as Higher and are equivalent once completed to a Foundation Degree.

Levels 6 & 7 apprenticeships are classed as Degree and are equivalent once completed to a Bachelor's Degree and Master's Degree.

As a young person you will have a choice of **three** pathways:

- Our **Community Learning SEND Provision** which includes courses based around the Preparing for Adulthood Outcomes. This pathway aims to support you to develop and improve your confidence and independence in and around: independent living skills, taking part in the local community, making good choices relating to health and exploring next steps after college. You will also have access to a range of Personal Development courses.
- Our **Employability and Careers Pathway** will also include courses around the Preparing for Adulthood outcomes however there will be more focus on gaining the skills needed to find employment including work placements.
- **Supported Internships:** If you are a young person with an **EHCP** you may be able to access our exciting new Supported Internship programme. On a Supported Internship you will have a personalised study programme and will have access to a work placement within Gateshead Council for up to four days a week.

Please note all of our prices are subject to change. Different courses will cost different amount depending on what you are studying.

Unfunded – Some of our courses are not funded by the government and therefore we must charge a fee for these. This will be different for each course, and we will always tell you what this fee is.

Full Price – We charge a fee for some of our courses. In most cases we will not charge you more than £5 per hour. However, we sometimes need to charge you more than this but will make sure we will tell you when you enrol.

Discounted Rates – If you earn under the national living wage (£20,319) then you may be eligible for a discount on our courses. Contact us on 0191 433 8646.

Free – Some of our courses are free and this will be listed in our prospectus and our website. If you are on benefits, you will not pay a fee.

Getting a concession

You can qualify for a concession if you earn under the National Living Wage or in receipt of Job Seekers' Allowance or Employment and Support Allowance (Work Related Activity Group) for those seeking skills training to help you into work. If you receive any other benefit such as Income Support or Disability Living Allowance and are enrolling on a course to help you gain skills to move into employment. Then you may also qualify for a concession.

If you think you qualify for a concessionary or discounted rate, you must bring evidence to support this when you enrol, such as benefit documentation. If you are over 60 or under 19 you must also bring evidence of this. We will also ask you for your National Insurance number. Please ensure that you bring this with you when you enrol.

Choosing the right course for you

When you enrol we will give you information on the course and answer any questions you may have. We have different levels of qualifications:

Entry Level. Aligned to the skills level of the National Curriculum, this level is for beginners.

Level 1. Designed for people who have either completed an Entry Level 3 or beginners course, or who have some knowledge or experience in the subject.

Level 2. Designed for people who already have quite a good knowledge of the subject and are becoming competent.

Level 3. For those advanced in the subject.

Level 4 and above. Specialist qualifications for those highly advanced in the subject.

All. A mixed ability class suitable for all levels.
